
Logistical notes



Getting there


- About a 1 mile walk from Sadler Center (A)

Options for tomorrow's time to explore


Tomorrow you can spend the afternoon exploring

2) Colonial Williamsburg

- Tomorrow you may wish to spend the free afternoon in the historic area
 - Colonial Capitol of Virginia

 - 88 original buildings from 1700s and early 1800s
 - 100s of building restored or reconstructed on original foundations
 - Active archeological sites
- Artisans and interpreters in period garb
 - blacksmith, silversmith ...
- Also, the original main campus building from the 1690s is also open – and still in use (Wren Hall)

- Jamestown (1607)
 - 1st permanent English settlement in America
- National historical park & archeological site

 - Interpretive center and Archaearium
- Jamestown Settlement
 - Interpretive museum
 - Life-size re-creations of the colonists' fort & a Powhatan Indian village
 - Life-size re-creations of the 3 ships
- Shuttle from Williamsburg Visitor center

 - Last return 5:00pm

- Last battle of the American Revolution
 - Site of civil war battles too
- Battlefield is a national park
- Nearby interpretive center, earthen works
