

Current CC/Collaboration Status and Issues

- With the departure of Seamus Riordan, GEN needs a new experiment representative on the CC (and possibly one or more new spokespeople).
- BigBite A1n no longer has PAC approval after PI group chose not to submit jeopardy update.
- For CC discussion:
 - Is it still appropriate for an experiment that no longer has PAC approval to have SBS CC representation?
 - Suggestion for CC discussion: Nilanga (currently A1n CC rep) becomes GEN rep in lieu of Seamus (this is not adding to Nilanga's workload, since he is already in the CC)?
- CC chair transition:
 - Outgoing chair Bogdan W.
 - Incoming chair A. Puckett (yours truly).
- CC meetings were held on an "as needed" basis over the last year, and attendance by CC members was sporadic.
- I plan to resume regular CC meetings (at least monthly, if not biweekly).
- Need to decide on Bogdan's proposal from the most recent collaboration meeting in February to create an "executive committee" distinct from the CC to formalize management of subsystems/subprojects/assignment and coordination of tasks.

- No formal requests for new regular members received in advance of this meeting \rightarrow Lots of new students and/or postdocs working on SBS projects. See introductions tomorrow.
- No proposed charter modifications were received for this meeting.
- We need a centrally maintained "official" SBS collaboration roster with current contact info for active collaborators, in order to manage communications/author lists/etc. in advance of installation/running.
 - Seamus had started putting this together before he left ANL. As new chair, I will finish organizing, using Seamus' spreadsheet compiled from proposal author lists and Hall A collaboration web-based roster of self-reported SBS involvement as a starting point.
- REMINDER—We (including but not limited to CC members) need to follow our own policy of informing the CC of SBS-related invited and contributed conference talks/abstracts/colloquia/seminars/etc, and upload slides to the SBS DocDB.
 - This is for record-keeping and coordination of talks/conference participation
 - CC pre-approval for routine SBS-related conference talks is NOT required

- Status and writing assignments/responsibility of documentation for GMN (COO/ESAD/RSAD/etc)
- Formalizing and documenting plans for calibration/commissioning/running of GMN and GEN-RP
