





The primary mission of the JLUO nominating committee is to select candidates for the annual elections to the JLUO Board of Directors (BoD).

The nominating committee might also consider nominating JLab users to other award and service committees within or outside JLab (eg DNP awards and committees).

The chair of the committee is the past-chair of the JLUO BoD and serves for one year. The four members-at-large each serve for four years and are nominated by the JLUO BoD chair.



### **Examples of Community building activities**

- Organize the Annual User <u>Meeting</u> and 2 satellite meetings (APS April and DNP Fall meetings)
- Young scientists: poster and lunch networking @ annual JLUO meeting, Software Carpentry Workshop
- Manage <u>JSA awards (Thesis Prize, Postdoc Prize, Poster Prize...)</u>
- Submit several continuing Initiatives Fund (IF) proposals

Most of the JLUO activities are supported by JSA.


### **Examples of User Representation at JLab activities**

- <u>JLab standing committees</u>: Director Safety council (E. Brash), JLab radiation review committee (C. Hyde), Director's Inclusion and Diversity Council (Y. Illieva)
- <u>PAC</u>: the JLUO chair is an *observer* of PAC deliberations and of the interactions between PAC members and proposers. Board suggests new PAC members to B. McKeown.
- Meet with lab management: JLab and JSA (twice a year each)
  - last meetings JSA: November, 2019; JLab: January 8, 2019.

## Flagship Outreach event: Nuclear Physics Day on the Hill

- JLab, RHIC, FRIB and fundamental symmetry user groups/organizations meet with the offices of senators and representatives
- JLab participants (7<sup>th</sup> year)
  - 2013: 7 persons
  - 2017: 23 from 13 states
  - 2018: 27 from 13 states
  - 2018: 25 from 8 states

# **JLUO Bylaws Reform**

Currently, JLUO is not incorporated and cannot solicit grants or other funds

- JLUO will register as JLUO, Inc., with assistance from SURA
- Bylaws will need to be reformed to meet requirements for an incorporation (define the membership and how they elect the board)
- The new Bylaws will maintain the spirit of the current Bylaws
- Who is a member? This hasn't been settled, but it may end up requiring an opt-in or signup, or it may be automatic (like the definition of "active user")
- Expect a vote on new Bylaws around the time of the annual meeting

    - 2 year registration for US citizens
