When was the last Accelerator Reliability Workshop held?

- The last ARW was held at CSNS in Guangzhou, China in 2019. The 2020 ARW was scheduled to take place in Newport News, Virginia. COVID delayed the workshop to October 2022. The local organizing committee is honored to host the first event in two years.
- In addition to the Newport News and Guangzhou, workshops have also been held at ESRF (Grenoble 2002), TRIUMF (Vancouver 2009), iThemba (Cape Town 2011), the Australian Synchrotron (Melbourne 2013), SNS (Knoxville 2015), Soleil (Versailles 2017), and CSNS (Guangzhou 2019).

REGISTRATION & PAYMENT

What are the registration fees and deadlines?

- Early Registration Fee \$675 USD per person (May 1 September 16, 2022)
- Late Registration Fee \$775 USD per person (after September 16, 2022)
- Optional fee for networking banquet and excursion \$150 per person

How do I register to participate and pay my registration fee for ARW 2022?

- Register your participation on the <u>ARW 2022 (Indico) website</u>.
 - This site will house all travel information, workshop and poster board session information, schedules, agendas, timelines, workshop presentations and participants contribution.



- *Pay* your registration fee on <u>JLab's website</u>.
 - Once payment has been made registrants will not need to return to this website. All workshop related information can be accessed via the ARW 2022 website.

How can I receive Early Registration pricing if I am paying the registration fee at the conference?

- The early registration fee will be extended to attendees who are paying at the conference when the following criteria are met during the early registration timeframe:
 - o Attendee registers on <u>JLab's</u> website (payment page). Instead of making payment, attendee should select the "Pay at Workshop" option.
 - o Attendee registers on the <u>Indico</u> website.

COMPLETION OF JLAB ELECTRONIC ACCESS REQUIRED BY ALL WORKSHOP ATTENDEES

Am I required to complete JLab's Electronic Access Registration Systems (EARS) to attend the workshop?

- Yes, <u>ALL</u> workshop attendees are required to complete JLab's Electronic Access Registration process at the following link at least 7 days before the start date of the workshop (10/16/2022): https://misportal.jlab.org/jlabAccess/.
 - o Choose "Visitor" as your JLab type.
 - o Complete your profile.
 - o Click on "Request a New Visit."
 - o Complete and submit the registration form.
 - Once, you submit the completed registration form, you will see a "checklist".
 - O Complete and submit all required forms and document uploads in the checklist in order for your registration request to be processed.
 - o You will receive an email once all is complete, approved and uploaded to our system.

VISA GUIDANCE FOR FOREIGN NATIONALS

Do I need to VISA to attend the workshop and, if so, how do I obtain one?

• It is imperative that foreign nationals enter the US with a business VISA at the US port-ofentry and have your passport stamped with a B1 or WB (business) stamp.

Visa Waiver Program (VWP) & Listing of Designated Countries:

- U.S. visa policy permits citizens of certain countries to travel to the U.S. without a visa, when
 they meet certain requirements, under U.S. laws. To determine if you are eligible for this
 program, go to the <u>Visa Waiver Program</u> website and consult the listing of participating VWP
 countries.
- If you are a citizen or national of a VWP designated country follow the instructions for completing the <u>Electronic System for Travel Authorization (ESTA) online form.</u>
- Your approved application will be electronically linked to your passport. At the US port-of-entry immigration officers will:
 - Scan your passport and electronically review your Visa Waiver to assign your visa category with a stamp in your passport:
 - YOU MUST SPECIFICALLY REQUEST THE IMIGRATION OFFICER TO STAMP YOUR PASSPORT WITH A "B1" OR "WB" BUSINESS STAMP.
 We recommend you have your Invitation Letter in-hand.
 - BEFORE LEAVING THE OFFICER AT THE PORT-OF-ENTRY, LOOK AT YOUR
 PASSPORT STAMP TO BE SURE IT IS CORRECT. IF IT IS NOT CORRECT, WORK
 WITH THE OFFICER TO OBTAIN THE CORRECT "B1" OR "WB" BUSINESS
 STAMP.

VISA:



• If your country is not a Visa Waiver Program (VWP) participant you will need a VISA to enter the USA. We urge you to apply for the VISA as early as possible. View the <u>Visa Wizard</u> on the US Embassy website to select the correct VISA type and follow the prompts. For additional VISA assistance visit the VISA resource webpage.

Send your request for an Invitation Letter to: ARW2022 @jlab.org and include the following information:

- Requestor's name, as it appears on their passport or official identification
- Affiliate organization name and address
- Attendee phone number and email address

Allow three working days for your request to be processed.

- Wear long pants or slacks Shorts, Capri pants, skirts, and dresses are not permitted.
- Wear short or long-sleeved shirts Sleeveless shirts or tank tops are not permitted.
- Wear flat or low-heeled, closed-toe shoes Sandals, open-toe or high heel shoes are not permitted.
