Publications, reviews, and PhDs

What's new since the last meeting:

- 2 papers published: 1 CLAS12 (Carman), 1 CLAS (Zachariou)
- 2 CLAS papers submitted to journals (Y. Tian's talk on Friday)

Ongoing reviews and PhDs:

- 2 paper in Collaboration-wide review (both CLAS12)
 - 1 paper in author check (CLAS)
 - 4 papers in Ad Hoc review (2 CLAS, 2 CLAS12)
 - 6 active analysis reviews ongoing in the 3 WG (3 CLAS, 3 CLAS12)
 - 38 ongoing PhDs according to our Theses online table

Optimization of the review/publication process:

- WG Chairs inform CLAS Chair when an analysis review is close to completion, CC starts forming an Ad Hoc committee right away
- using Service Work Committee reviews outcomes to pick Ad Hoc reviewers
- keeping a close eye on Ad Hoc reviews to minimize time

WG Chairs elections, CAA vote, CoC vote

The terms of the 4 WG Chairs have arrived at the end:

- nominating committees have been or are being established
- voting should take place during the summer
- only full members can be WG chairs

The CCC was informed of irregularities and conflicts within the nominating committee for the HSWG chair. The CCC has decided to suspend the HSWG chair nomination procedure and election. We will organize the HSWG chair election for the fall CLAS Meeting.

On Friday we'll have a presentation by G. Clash (York) on a CAA (Hexaquarks at CLAS12) which was reviewed by the HWSG and will have to be voted by the Collaboration for final approval after the presentation
