# Result of CoC vote

- Thanks to the Full Members who voted, The Code of Conduct proposed at the March meeting has been approved and will become part of the CLAS Collaboration Charter:

*“The members of the CLAS collaboration are expected to act in an ethical, civilized, and collaborative manner at all times. Scientific discussions and debates are always welcome as long as they are constructive and carried out with politeness and respect. The CLAS members shall not engage in harassment or bullying, nor discriminate against each other, in particular on the basis of sex, age, religion, beliefs, nationality, culture, ethnicity, sexual orientation, gender identity, career status, disability, or family situation. All CLAS members are expected to work with the utmost scientific integrity, and respect the confidentiality of internal information as described in the CLAS Charter and By-Laws.”*
