

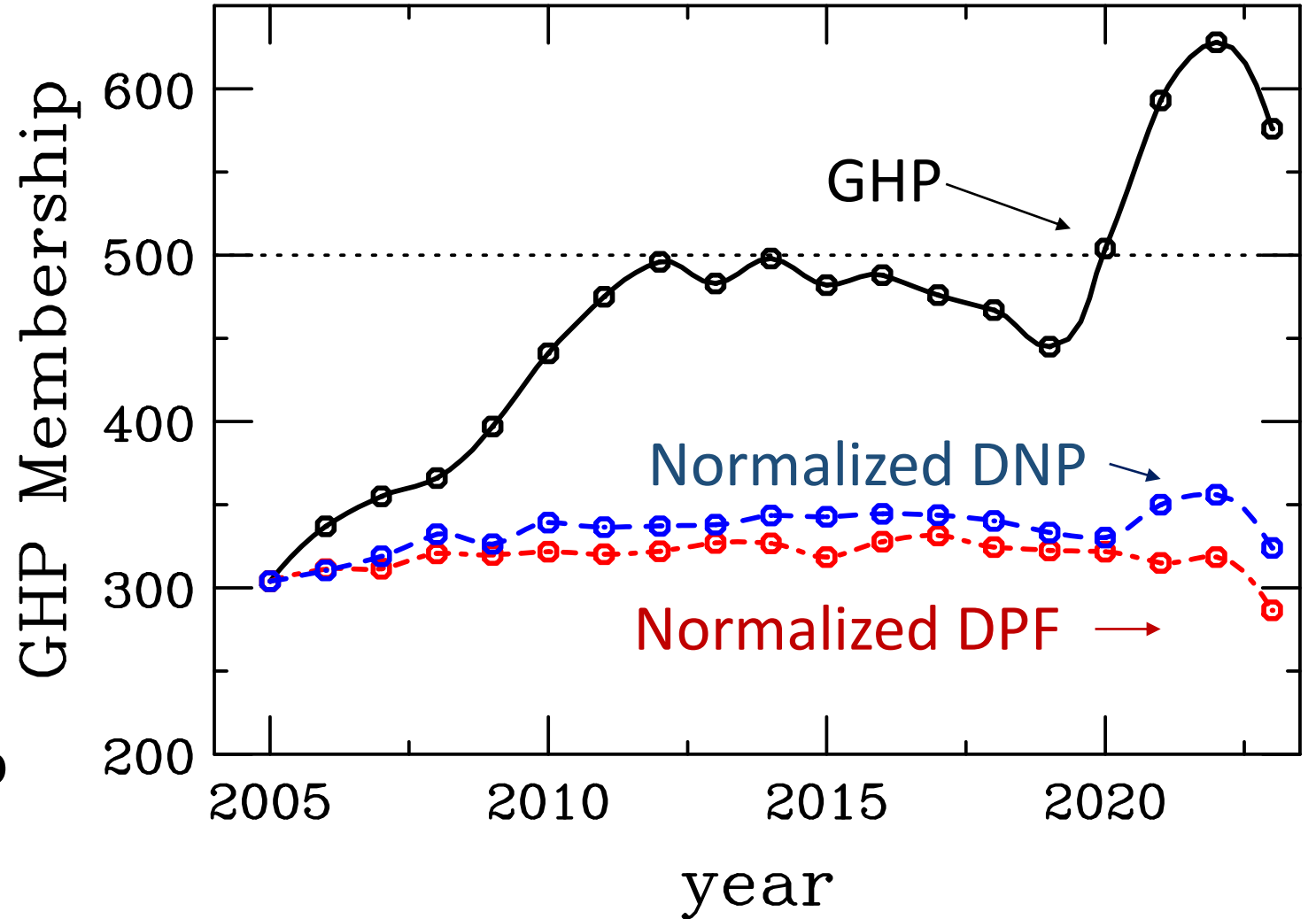
GHP Secretary-Treasurer Report

Membership

- 2023 vs 2022: 8% decrease
Still 7th in size out of 13 topical groups
1.2% of APS

GHP Membership Benefits

- Biennial meeting: next one in 2023
- Two APS Fellows per year
- Dissertation award (now Annual, in part due to members' generosity)
- Sorting categories at April meeting, leading to large presence:
 - 2 Invited sessions co-sponsored with DNP plus 1 standalone GHP
 - 3 GHP-sponsored mini-symposia
 - 5 contributed sessions
- Newsletters

GHP General Fund

- At end of 2022, GHP General Fund had a balance of \$31,428.35
- Main source of funds from dues (allocated at the beginning of calendar year)
- Other major source from meetings:
 - In general some income from April meeting because of our sorting category
 - Biennial GHP meeting we attempt to break even

Dissertation award

- As of Dec 2022 funded at \$44,705.68
 - This is sufficient to maintain an **annual** award
