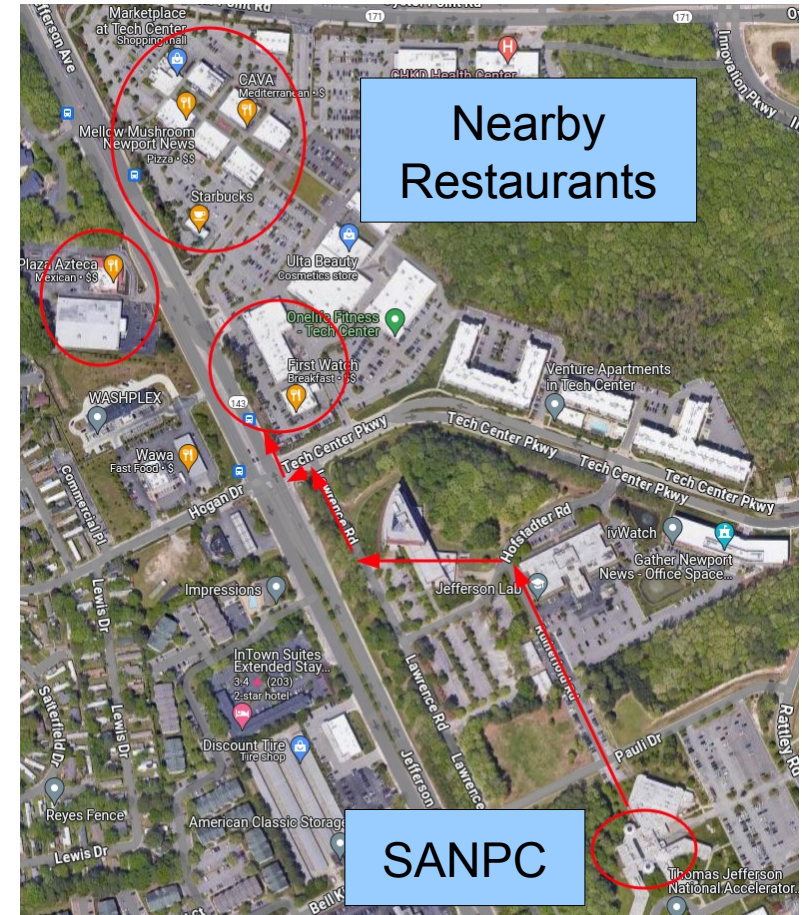

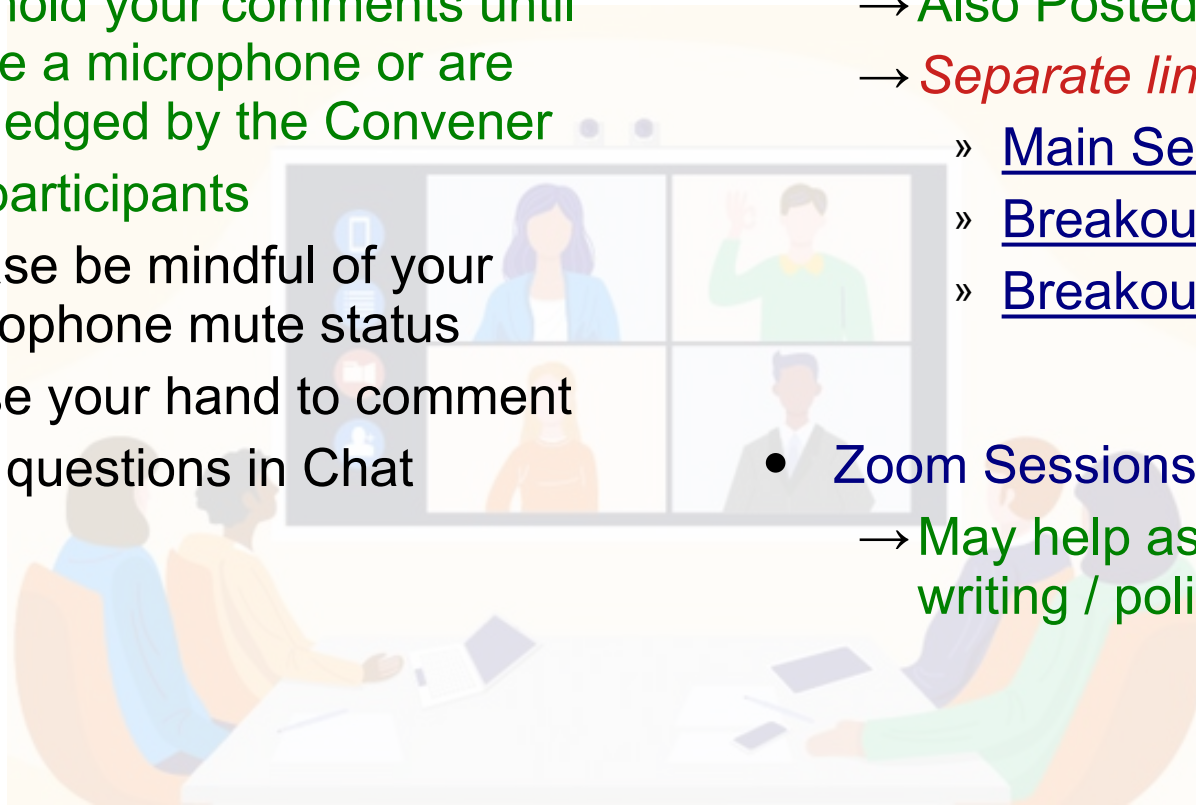
Food / Coffee / Welcome Event Locations
