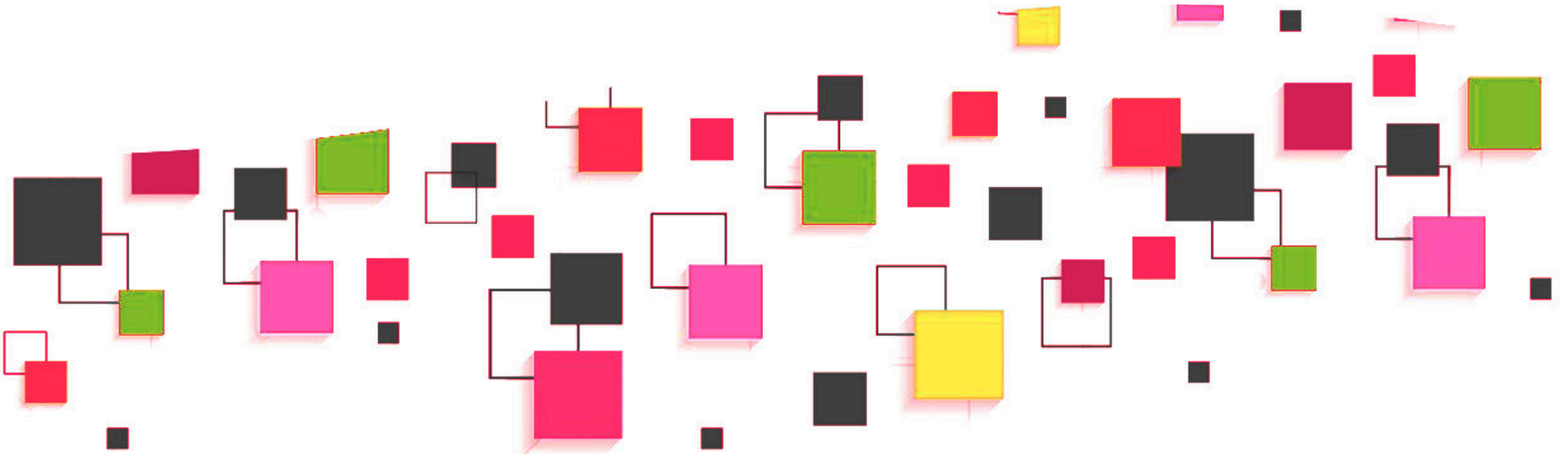

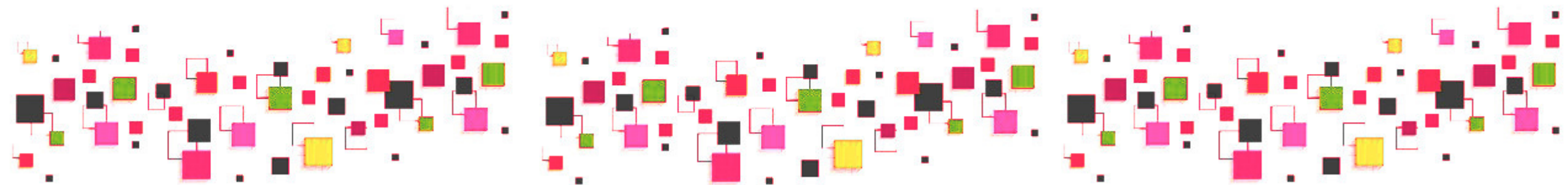

- As of today (end of may 2024): 3 (+ 1 outreach poster for the general audience)

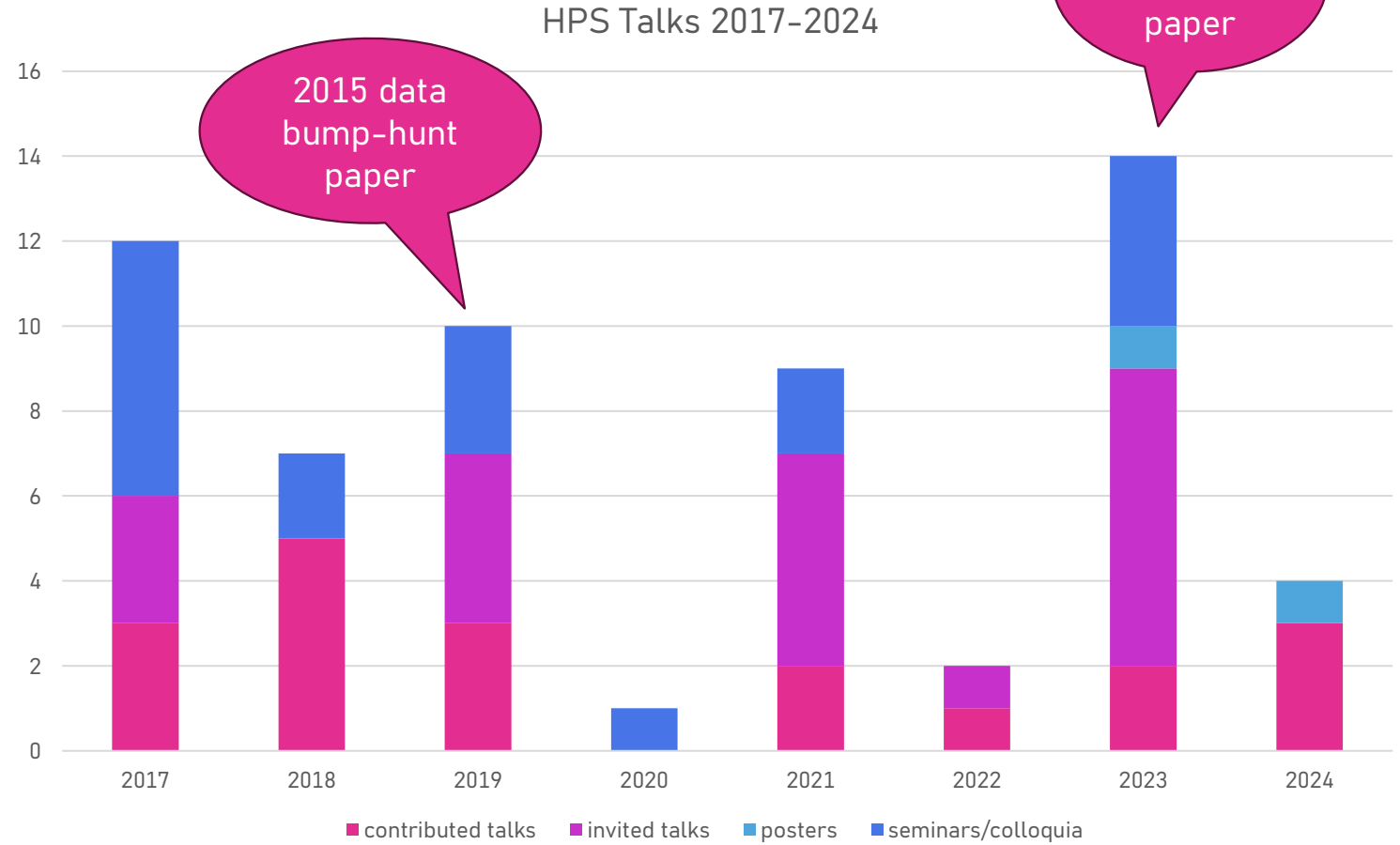

RULES REFRESHER IN A NUTSHELL

BEFORE YOU GIVE A TALK

NO INVITATION – you want to attend a conference and give a presentation

Is the conference on the PPC list? If not, let the PPC know

1. Prepare the abstract – need help? Let us know and we'll provide good templates
2. **Let the PPC review the abstract before submission – submit it to PPC at least two weeks before conference deadline**
3. Good to go, everything approved? Submit the abstract yourself
4. Let PPC know whether it has been accepted

2-WEEK RULE

INVITATION RECEIVED

You **MUST** notify PPC of the invitation if you plan to speak about HPS

PREPARING THE TALK

- Need help to prepare the presentation? Let PPC know (in due time and well in advance)
- Which material can be used?
 - All published results
 - All approved plots (they can be found in the repository)
 - For new material permission must be required (so plan to ask it in due time)
- **Let PPC review the presentation circulating it at least two weeks in advance**
- Do you need a dry run? PPC can organize a practice talk session (if notified in advance)

2-WEEK RULE

AFTER THE TALK

- Store your final presentation on the PPC confluence page (or send it to PPC)
- Report shortly about the outcome/audience reactions at one of the first Wednesday meetings after your presentation

POST-PRODUCTION: PROCEEDINGS?

- Hassle, we all know – but it's one more publication on your list
- You are invited to prepare them, if required – PPC can help you in writing
- **Let PPC have your manuscript well in advance before the deadline for the submission (at least two weeks)**

2-WEEK RULE

YOU ARE WELCOME TO PRESENT HPS RESULTS!

- It is important to improve the visibility of our results and our Collaboration
- If you can go to present HPS... please do it!
 - You are always welcome, also if it's just a poster
 - If you need help, the PPC can provide it
- If you mention HPS in your general/review/invited talks or seminar/colloquia, please notify all the same
