

HPS TALKS IN 2025 – first 6 months


- As of end of may 2025: 6 talks (4 contributed + 2 invited)

 - Conferences in Europe potentially problematic for travels



PPC Rules Refresher All you need to know

Before the talk

- No invitation? Choose from the updated list of events or request a new addition. Notify PPC, prepare your abstract (ask for help if needed) and submit it to PPC 2 weeks before submission deadline for approval. Notify PPC if/when the talk has been accepted.
- With invitation? If the talk involves HPS and/or its results, MUST notify PPC.

While preparing

- Use approved plots and published results only. Any exceptions require a 2/3 collaboration vote.
- Share your slides 2 weeks ahead for review. Want feedback/need training? We can schedule a practice session.
- Circulate final version for last-minute input.

After the talk

- Submit your final slides to the PPC repository, also in case of invited talks
- Proceedings? Submit manuscript 2 weeks before deadline for internal review by the Collaboration. Only include published/approved material. Request exceptions well in advance.

- It is important to improve the visibility of our results and our Collaboration
- If you can go to present HPS... please do it!
 - You are always welcome, also if it's just a poster
